DANCE WORKSHOP

CONSTITUTION PROMENADE

19:00 Cuban dance workshop

Dancer and choreographer Ana Laura Martínez will lead a practical workshop to introduce participants to the exciting world of Afro-Cuban dance: a brief journey from its tribal origins to the most popular steps of Cuban son and salsa. The goal is to develop participants' understanding of the fundamentals of Cuban son through learning its basic steps and rhythm.

22:00 Ede & Fe Quintet

Edelmi Pedroso and Fernando Wilhemi attempt to summarize their new project in a simple phrase: "Jazz in Spanish." Drawing on popular music from various Spanish- and Portuguese-speaking countries, they have created a melodic and harmonic universe adapted to the concept of jazz improvisation. This has resulted in a collection of standards sung in Spanish by artists such as Bola de Nieve, Chabuca Granda, Portillo de la Luz, Martha Valdés, Chico Buarque, Ary Barroso, María Grever, Fernando Mulens, Aldemaro Romero, and José Antonio Méndez, as well as original compositions with music and lyrics by Fernando Wilhelmi.

24:00 Timbalito Street Cuartet

Timbalito Street is a Cuban music quartet founded in 2011 by Lino Díaz, a Cuban pianist and tres player, along with Lupe Amador, also Cuban, on vocals and percussion. By adding Fernando Wilhelmi, a flautist, saxophonist, and composer with extensive experience in the traditional music of Cuba and Brazil and in Latin jazz, and Rolando Díaz, a Cuban percussionist and founder of Charanga Habanera, they have achieved an ideal formula that combines tradition and innovation in a single performance with flavors of both Cuban past and present.

REAL STREET

14:00 Brassbandicot

Brassbandicot brings together the finest contemporary jazz from Granada. Specializing in the New Orleans "second line" style (funk and jazz), they bring the energetic and festive spirit of traditional American street brass bands to the Andalusian music scene.

22:00 Daniel Amat & Francis Posé Trío

A sonic journey through the diverse styles and eras of Latin jazz and Cuban music: bolero, rumbas, son, danzón, guajira, and more are part of their repertoire, along with original compositions by both artists. Daniel Amat (current pianist for Buena Vista Social Club) and Francis Posé (one of the great double bassists on the Spanish jazz scene) have collaborated on numerous projects in recent years, resulting in the recording of the albums "Hermano" and "Ajiaco." On this occasion, they will be accompanied by the renowned drummer and composer Jessie Valdés, grandson and son of the legendary musicians Bebo and Chucho Valdés.

24:00 La Quinta Sonera

La Quinta Sonera has a deep, solid musical foundation, enveloped in the magic of Caribbean rhythms and a fusion with other genres. Their live performances are energetic and captivating. They recently released their first album, "Bueno pa bailar" (Good for Dancing). They are a true gift for lovers of good Latin music. The usual Latin trio (vocals, bass, piano, and percussion) will be augmented by an excellent horn section.
